Library Network Manager's Lowdown



The MobileCirc software has finally arrived. I have been playing around with inventory and I have to say it's much better than before. So far I have only been testing it with a wireless connection. This makes all the difference because an inventory can be accomplished in real time. This also means no more files to upload which was especially painful with the PocketCirc software.

The MobileCirc software told me in real time which items were out of order, which items were not in the system, and which items were fine. However, it was unclear whether it was able to determine that an item from another library was included in the inventory. The post-physical inventory process has not changed that much. Unfortunately a multitude of reports still have to be run after the items have been inventoried.

A patch to the Symphony server was necessary so that we could start beta testing MobileCirc. This patch should not have impacted your operations and did not add any additional features beyond those particular to MobileCirc.

Megan began training library staff and she had a very successful first month. She conducted five different training sessions ranging from RFID programming to cataloging. She is doing a fantastic job and we are very pleased she has been able to fill a sorely needed void in our services.

Jim also patched the Circ-It server becaused Tech Logic's publisher security certificate had lapsed. Features were not updated or upgraded in any fashion. Of course the security certificate patch did cause a few problems with some of our libraries which were resolved (for the most part) quickly.

The Enterprise server purchase was approved by the Board of Supervisors and is being ordered as I write this. Here is the current schedule for our implementation from the SirsiDynix side:

Sept 30 Server connectivity test

Oct 2-4 Enterprise install

Oct 14-17 Virtual training for YLN staff

Oct 22 Enterprise SureStart consulting call #1

Oct 25 Theme Customization (done by SirsiDynix)

Oct 28 Enterprise SureStart consulting call #2

Oct 30 Enterprise configuration followup (SirsiDynix)
