Happy September!

During my first month on the job, I was able to visit 28 of our member libraries. I spent additional time at Mayer Public Library, Prescott Public Library, and Yavapai College learning their operating procedures and noting their similarities and differences. I plan on visiting the remainder of our libraries in the next few months, so if I haven't met you yet, I will see you soon.

We are looking forward to our YES (Yavapai Events Services) Calendar training this month. The YLN and pilot libraries will be trained next week as well as Yavapai County Developmental Services. With the YES Calendar project, the community will have one place that they will be able to search for events within our county. Stay tuned for more details as we learn more about the product.

We will also be enhancing our RBDigital collection to include audiobooks this month. These audiobooks will be all simultaneous use, with no holds or waitlists. Titles can be downloaded to your home computer, or to a mobile device using the RBDigital app. Look for our upcoming press release and instructions on usage in the next few weeks.

This month, we began "Tech Tip Tuesday" to share technical related tips for using the Yavapai Library Network. The idea is to share a quick little tip that might make your computer usage a little easier. If you have any tips you'd like to share, please let us know, and we'll include them in future weeks.

We now have 2 protective cases for the Tech Logic shelf management wands. They can be checked out for 3 weeks and can be used to identify items that

should not be on your shelf using the RFID tags, and the status in the catalog. Check one out and see what it can do for you!

Interviewing continues for the Library Cataloging position which is open until filled. Eric continues to cover the duties until someone is found. A new seasonal transit driver, Tod, started this month to fill in when needed so that there is less interruption in delivery schedules.

I would like to thank Chanel, Sherryl and all my YCFLD co-workers, and member libraries for supporting and training me during my first month. I have a lot more to learn, and I appreciate your patience while I come up to speed.

Prioritization

Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone, then a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

Priority Two: Community Calendar

Libraries have requested a community calendar for years, but there was no solution available. Calendar software for the library market is now being developed.

Goal: Implement a community calendar

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

- Evaluate available calendaring products
- Get quote
- Apply for LSTA grant
- Sign contract for product (if needed)
- Implement calendar
- Go live with a subset of pilot libraries
- Roll it out to the Network
- Test with a community organization
- Open it up to all organizations that would like to participate

Priority Three: Move Servers from Ubuntu to RHEL

Our Ubuntu servers are not playing well with the Hyper-V host. Red Hat is better supported on Hyper-V. The District and ITS already bought two RHEL licenses. The Network will be buying the rest.

Goal: Move servers to RHEL so they will be more stable.

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

- Purchase RHEL licenses
- Move portal server to RHEL
- Move ylnstest server to RHEL
- Move help desk server to RHEL
- Move helptest server to RHEL
- Move optio server to RHEL
- Move district server to RHEL
- Move districttest server to RHEL
- Move authentication server to RHEL

Note concerning prioritization: The priority of projects may shift as individual portions are completed.

Prioritization

Priority Four: Improve Database Quality

Enhance the operation of the catalog for patrons and staff by improving material description, subject and genre access, and data integrity. These tasks are for materials already in Symphony.

Goal: Improve patron and staff search experience

Project Lead: Eric Petersen

- Correct structurally invalid bibliographic records in Symphony
- Complete cataloging and descriptions of Adult Books
- Add Subject Headings and Genre Headings to bibliographic records that lack them
- Complete cataloging and description of Youth Books
- Complete cataloging and descriptions of Adult non-book materials
- Complete cataloging and description of Youth non-book materials
- Clean-up genre headings to conform to current standards

Priority Five: Implement Blue Cloud Cataloging

Blue Cloud Cataloging will allow library staff to access Symphony cataloging from a web browser. The new product should have significant user interface improvements above the cataloging section in WorkFlows.

Goal: Fully implement Blue Cloud Cataloging (BCC)

Project Lead: Eric Petersen

- Upgrade Web Services so we can use BCC
- Configure Web Services for the new service
- Test BCC to see how it works
- Create documentation
- Activate it for a test library to see how it works in a production environment
- Conduct a training session for all YLN users
- Activate it for the remaining libraries
